PRESS INFORMATION

Berlin is the international capital of art. In every section of the city, fresh, vibrant creativity thrives outside the big exhibition venues and art markets, waiting to be discovered. Berlin's twenty-eight municipal galleries drive and promote these creative processes and experiments. They are decentralized, local organisations; for artists living and working in Berlin, they are frequently debut public presentation venues and quite often act as springboards into the international art scene. For Berlin Art Week, Berlin's municipal galleries once again highlight the city's creativity at KGB KUNSTWOCHE from September 9 - 18. The program consists of bus tours through different districts, city walks with artists (Artist Walks), special programs accompanying current exhibitions and the thematic evening event "What use is Art?" (*Was nützt Kunst?*). The KGB-Kunstwoche finale is a night of concerts — KGB-Sounds — featuring participating visual artists at Heimathafen Neukölln.

On both weekends, **Artist Walks** leave from various gallery spaces, exploring artistic interventions and excursions in urban spaces of each area from unusual perspectives. **The theme evening, "What use is Art?"** on Monday, September 12, features artist Ellen Kobe in a performative guided tour of the history of Schwarzsche Villa and philosopher Marcus Steinweg muses on whether the work of artists is actually needed by others. The collective action culminates on Saturday, September 17 in three **KGB Bus Tours** linking several areas of the city. Over five hours, every tour visits five galleries, where the director of each presents the program focus of the space. Afterwards, Heimathafen Neukölln hosts the KGB-Kunstwoche closing event, **KGB Sounds – The Night of Artists' Bands**, with Beating The Drum/N.U. Unruh, dangerpony, Artists On Horses and Black Heino (free admission), followed by a DJ set from planningtorock – an auditory final note to a week of visual impact.
